If your application is accepted and a policy is issued to you, it will provide mine subsidence coverage.

Illinois law requires that mine subsidence coverage be provided in your property insurance policy unless waived by you in writing. Mine subsidence insurance, provided by the Illinois Mine Subsidence Insurance Fund, provides a maximum of \$350,000 or the amount of coverage on the dwelling, whichever is less, for property damage to the structure caused by mine subsidence. Mine subsidence means lateral or vertical ground movement resulting from the collapse of man-made underground mines, including but not limited to coal, clay, limestone and fluorspar mines, which directly damages structures. Mine subsidence does not mean lateral or vertical ground movement caused by earthquake, landslide, volcanic eruption, soil conditions or caused by collapse of storm or sewer drains or rapid transit tunnels. The deductible stated on the Declarations Page will apply to each loss.
